FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is there shade? Yes! Worship will be held in a tent with overflow tents available, if needed.

My mobility is limited. Will this be a problem? No! Ushers will be at the quarry entrance to assist you. Just let one of them know you need help.

What should I bring?

- Marked lawn chair
- Any drinks other than water
- Marked life jacket, if planning to swim
- Sunscreen

NOTE: Please mark any utensils or containers you would like returned if you bring a dessert. Markers will be available in the first-aid tent, if needed.

What's on the menu? We will serve sandwiches, hot dogs, chips, fruit, and veggies. If you have any dietary restrictions or allergies, we ask that you please pack your own lunch. **BONUS!** A free lemon shake-up (first one is on us, then \$5 after; flavorings are extra).

Will lifeguards be on duty? Yes! Certified lifeguards will be present to ensure safety. Children 16 and younger will be provided a bracelet corresponding to their swimming ability. Please ensure they are worn. Lifejackets are required if your child does not swim well. Some lifejackets will be available to use but are limited. We ask that you remain on the beach while your child is swimming.

What facilities are available?

- Portable restrooms
- Tents for shade
- First-aid tent

NOTE: Please wear swimsuits under your clothes, as a changing area will <u>not</u> be provided. Please remember modesty when choosing swimming attire.

Is there anything for toddlers/infants to do? Yes! We will have a children's area for your littles during worship. A tent will also be set up at the beach area (along with sand toys) for families.

Can I bring a kayak or go fishing?

Yes! Life jackets are required while in a kayak.

Will there be an offering time?

Yes, tithes will be collected during worship. Also, a free-will offering bucket will be provided during the lunch hour. Or you can give online.

Can I get baptized on the 24th?

Yes! Please contact the office or Pastor Ryan before August 21.

What happens in the event of inclement weather? Worship will be held at the church. A decision will be made by Saturday, August 23 at 10 p.m. and shared with the congregation via Flocknote.
